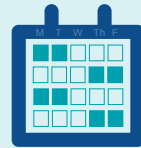


Highlights of the Re-entry Plan



Grades PreK-5 Students

are in school full time



Grades 6-12 Students

attend classes in person two days a week and learn remotely for three days a week



Most Vulnerable Student Groups

may attend in school four days [grades 6-12] or five days [grades preK-5]



Capacity

allows access to meals, works with current staffing, works with current building capacities



Protocols

for wearing face coverings, conducting health screenings, regular handwashing & practicing social distancing are in place



Devices

students will bring their devices to school, if possible



Deep Cleaning for Buildings

on Wednesdays for grades 6-12, on Friday after school/evenings for grades PreK-5 and Public Separate Schools



Use of SWIVL*



Some Grade Levels

at some schools with limited capacity will have to attend alternate sites**



Split Space

Some grade levels will have to be split across two spaces

* SWIVL is a device that holds a camera and rotates to follow the teacher automatically.

** Affects Rankin and Morehead Elementary Schools.

Notes:

- Students enrolled in Guilford eLearning Virtual Academy and Guilford eLearning University Prep will continue learning in their virtual environments they began in August 2020.
- This Plan allows for the most vulnerable student groups including some students with disabilities, Public Separate Schools, students in first years of language acquisition, students in foster care, students with multiple risk factors and homeless students in grades PreK-5 and Public Separate Schools to attend full time Monday-Friday and grades 6-12 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.
