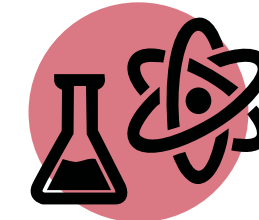
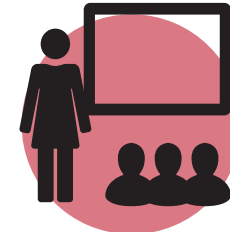


3. Complete and submit an application!
