 <p>Technology Distribution to K-5 students can be reassigned to middle and high school students who still need a device</p>	 <p>Teacher Planning on Fridays for teachers in grades 6-12 who are teaching remotely and face to face</p>	 <p>6-12 students only attend face to face four days a week every other week</p>	 <p>6-12 students may not have access to meals for 5 consecutive school days on an A Week/B Week schedule</p>	  <p>Split Space Some PreK-5 classrooms will have to be split across two spaces</p>	 <p>Staggered Start for PK-5 to accommodate transportation</p>
 <p>PreK-5 students are in school full time</p>	 <p>50% of 6-12 students students attend remotely</p>	 <p>50% of 6-12 students students attend face to face</p>	 <p>Use of SWIVL required</p>	 <p>Meal Service limits may impact school nutrition staffing</p>	 <p>4th and/or 5th grades at some schools will have to attend a middle school</p>
