ASMC [75th Anniversary Membership Award]

Objective

The objective of this award is to recognize American Society of Military Comptroller (ASMC) members for outstanding accomplishment within the quarterly themes of the ASMC 75th anniversary jubilee, as a part of the overall anniversary celebration.

Award Criteria

Nominee must be a member of ASMC in good standing at the time of nomination. Nomination application is based on any minimum six-month period of time, spanning the 75-year history of ASMC.

Submission Requirements

Any current ASMC chapter officer may nominate member(s) for a 75th Anniversary Membership Award. Nomination must be submitted via the Awards Online website by the category deadline. Justification should cite specific examples and factual details of the experience, skills and accomplishments within the quarterly category chosen.

Q1: Comptroller on the Battlefield

This category recognizes those who serve front line commands in the planning, management, and control of finance and accounting, budget, and audit readiness to ensure cash is flowing and all needs are met to "finance the fight."

Q2: Budget/PPBE of Past, Present and Future Developing and defending the budget is critical, and there is great opportunity to modernize the process to make it more streamlined, effective, transparent and trust based. This category recognizes defense financial managers that apply previous and current knowledge of systems and requirements to enhance future budget operations.

Q3: Comptroller of the Future Workforce Nominees in this category are defense financial managers exceling as a strategic partner to operational managers providing data-driven insights and value throughout the development and implementation of a new requirement.

Q4: Innovation

This category recognizes those that create a new method, idea or product that results in increased productivity, improvement and/or minimization of redundant tasks. These innovations could include, but are not limited to, robotics, machine learning, artificial intelligence, and analytical optimization.

Award Selection Procedures

Up to two winners will be selected from each of the quarterly categories.

Judging will be based on outstanding performance as evidenced by documentation of complexity, results and impact on the defense financial management community. Any judges that have or develop any conflicts of interest in judging will recuse themselves.

The selection panel, chaired by Awards Committee, will include not less than five members that represent a cross section of ASMC Membership. The selection panel will review and judge all nominations received through the online form by the due date.

Recognition

Awards will be presented at local chapter and regional events. The recipients may be publicized at chapter meetings, in newsletters, on the ASMC website and in the Armed Forces Comptroller.

Deadline

Nominations must be submitted by (Q1) February 22, (Q2) May 1, (Q3) August 1, and (Q4) November 1 to be considered by the selection panel. No exception to this deadline will be allowed.
